The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.57 dated 23.01.2022 under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala (Sections 406 IPC has been inadvertently typed as Section 404 IPC in the impugned order).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.06.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 02.06.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 02.06.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
