Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the father of the petitioner, who was working as Work Mate with the respondent/HVPNL, had expired on 03.09.1996 while the petitioner was only five years old. The petitioner has preferred an application for appointment on compassionate ground to the respondents after attaining the age of majority, which is still pending. He also submits that the petitioner has sent a legal notice dated 27.01.2020 (Annexure P-7) in this regard to the respondents but no action has been taken thereon.

At the asking of the Court, Dr. Kapil Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.01.2020 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
