Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 168 dated 07.06.2007, registered under Sections 406, 409, 420, 415, 468, 471, 34, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station DLF, Phase-II, Gurgaon (now Gurugram).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were granted the concession of interim bail on 19.03.2013 and during the intervening period, there is no allegation that the petitioners have either misused the concession of interim bail or have tried to influence the witnesses in any manner.

The aforesaid fact is not disputed by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 19.03.2013, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
