This writ petition in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* is filed stating that Rupinder Kaur (detenue) is in illegal custody of respondent No.4 (father of the detenue).

As per the pleadings, petitioner solemnized marriage with the detenue on 1st July, 2020, the parents of the detenue were not happy with the marriage. The petitioner moved an application before the Senior Superintendent of Police, but no action was taken, hence the present petition was filed for release of the detenue from the illegal detention of her father.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the position on the last two dates.

State had filed reply dated 12th August, 2021 annexing the affidavit of detenue. As per the affidavit, the detenue is living with her father with her own sweet will. There is no dispute between her and her father. It is stated that petitioner got her signatures on the complaint without disclosing the contents and she wants to reside with her parents.

In view of the reply filed, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of.
