Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, a prayer has been made for deleting the conditions which have been imposed in the order dated 13.08.2020 (Annexure P-10) that the release of the benefits to the petitioner will be subject to the outcome of the ***CRM-A-578-MA-2013 titled as U.T. Of Chandigarh Vs. Om Parkash,*** but the same kindly be treated as not pressed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by the order dated 13.08.2020 (Annexure P-10), the respondents has already undertaken to release consequential benefits but the actual benefits are not released to the petitioner and that to without any justification .

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that once the petitioner already stands acquitted by a competent Court of law in respect of criminal proceedings and the departmental proceedings initiated have

already been dropped, respondents are under an obligation to release the granted consequential benefits without any delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a representation dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-11) upon them, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his legal notice, respondent No. 3 is directed to decide the representation dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P/11) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
