Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.0013 dated 05.05.2022 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Women Police Station, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla.

On 06.06.2022 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0013 dated 05.05.2022 under Section 498-A IPC registered at Women Police Station Malerkotla, District Malerkotla.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that totally false and fabricated allegations have been levelled against him by his wife in the FIR in question (Annexure P-1), which is evident from the fact that there is no convincing and cogent evidence available to substantiate the allegations. Learned counsel further submits that a highly unbelievable version had been put forth by the complainant wife as she had never been subjected to cruelty in connection with any demands of dowry.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined investigation; has cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In the light of the reasons stated in the afore quoted order as also the statement made on behalf of the State, the order of this Court dated 06.06.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
