Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail
to the petitioners in case FIR No.144 dated 29.04.2021, under Section
498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dera
Bassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Vide order dated 16.07.2021 while granting interim
protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that
pursuant to order dated 16.07.2021, petitioners have joined the

investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and reiterates the allegations regarding harassment caused by the petitioners to the complainant.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gorav Sharma, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation. However, he submits that some of the dowry articles remains to be effected.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the Court is satisfied that the matter needs to be thoroughly investigated and thereafter tried by the trial Court. Simply because recovery of some dowry articles remains to be effected cannot be a ground for rejection of the bail at this stage.

In view of the above, interim order dated 16.07.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
