The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, 1950 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondent No.2 to take necessary action as contemplated under Section 55 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 for cancelling of the Certificate of Registration of Vehicle bearing No.PB-32-V-9665 (Annexure P-1) as the said vehicle met with an accident on 27.03.2021 and the same was declared to be total loss in the Motor Survey Report dated 12.04.2021.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Baljinder Singh Dhillon, presently posted as Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Registering Authority, Nawanshahr on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed today in the Court. A copy thereof has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.

The relevant extract of the same reads thus:-

4. *That at the very outset it is submitted that the grievance of the petitioner as raised in the present petition has been redressed and Registration Certificate of Vehicle bearing No. PB32-V-9665 has been cancelled on 16.08.2022. The letter evidence the same annexed with the reply as Annexure R-1. Further it is submitted that the same has been received by the petitioner on date 18.08.2022. Receipt annexed as Annexure R-2.*

5. *That after the submission of requisite documents by the petitioner which are necessarily required for issuing cancellation of RC has been submitted by the petitioner and thereafter the same was processed and RC cancellation Certification issued immediately without any delay on the part of Respondents.*

In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no surviving cause of action.

Present petition is accordingly disposed of.
