The present revision petition has been filed impugning the order dated 23.3.2021 passed by the learned Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh in case FIR No.31 dated 6.3.2021 registered under section 363 IPC (later on added sections 302, 376 IPC and sections 4 & 6 of POCSO Act) at Police Station, Sector 31, Chandigarh as well as order dated 2.6.2021 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Fast Track Special Court, Chandigarh whereby appeal of the petitioner has been dismissed and order of learned Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh has been upheld.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined by the learned Trial Court and the case is fixed for arguments.

In view of the above position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, at this stage.
