Mr.Lokesh Sinhal, Sr. Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, and Mr.Ashish Rawal, Advocate, assisted counsel of Mr.Satyapal Jain, Sr. Advocate, Addl. Solicitor General for India, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4.

It is the case of the petitioners that against the order dt.02.05.2022 passed by respondent No.2, petitioner had preferred appeal to respondent No.1 and also sought interim relief; and that there is a threat of the mining license being terminated before the appeal or the interim relief prayer is decided by the appellate authority.

Mr.Lokesh Sinhal, Sr. Addl. A.G., Haryana appearing for respondents No.1 to 3 states that respondent No.1 will decide the appeal within a period of two months, and the interim relief prayer made by the petitioners shall also be decided as early as possible.
