ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is presently residing in Australia and during his visit to India in the month of May, he was threatened by the private respondents.

Given above, when the petitioner would again travel to India, he shall inform the concerned SP/SHO, who shall provide him protection for seven days. During the protection period, the petitioner shall remain within the boundaries of his house and shall leave only for medical emergency and bereavement of his close relatives. However, if the petitioner no longer requires the protection, then at his request, it may be discontinued even before the expiry of one week. After that, the concerned officers shall extend the protection on day-to-day analysis of the ground realities or upon the oral or written request of the petitioner.

With the aforementioned observations, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty reserved to the petitioner to file separate petitions for the remaining prayers.
