The petitioner has challenged the transfer order whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Chonda to Malerkotla.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier preferred a writ petition and the respondents were directed to decide the same. The representation of the petitioner has been decided by a non-speaking order.

Heard.

The petitioner has been transferred from Chonda to Malerkotla, which is at a distance of about 40 kms. In the impugned order, the representation of the petitioner has been declined on the ground that there is no available post at Malerkotla.

I do not find any infirmity in the impugned order, which would warrant interference while exercising writ jurisdiction especially when the petitioner has been transferred to a place which is only 40 kms away.

The petition stands dismissed.
