Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner was claiming promotion to the post of Auction Recorder, which was granted to another employee junior to the petitioner.

Learned counsel submits that the action of the respondents in not granting the promotion to the petitioner to the post of Auction Recorder has been agitated by the petitioner before respondent No.2 by way of filing an appeal dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said appeal by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the appeal dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the appeal dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the appeal dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-3), if not already decided, within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.
