This common order shall dispose of above noted two petitions
as they arise out of the same FIR.

Prayer in these petitions, filed under Section 438 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioners Tarun
Vaid @ Tanu and Deepak Vaid @ Bau in case FIR No. 0111 dated
25.05.2020, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs &
Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar,
Jalandhar Police Commissionerate.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were granted the concession of regular bail by the Judge, Special Court, vide orders dated 08.02.2021 and 24.12.2020, respectively, and they were regularly appearing before the Court, however, on the last date i.e. 17.05.2022, they could not appear before the trial Court as they had gone to visit Maata Chintpurni Temple but could not return in time. It is further submitted that the petitioners have moved an application for exemption before the trial Court but the same was declined and the bail/surety bonds of the petitioners were cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against them.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for grant of fresh bail. It is further submitted that the petitioners, while granted regular bail, have submitted cash surety of Rs. 50,000/- each.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not dispute the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petitions are disposed of with a direction to petitioners to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and on doing so, the trial Court will release them on bail, subject to their furnishing fresh bail bonds and on the same surety of Rs. 50,000/- each, which is already lying deposited with the Court.

Till the time the petitioners appear before the trial Court, their arrest shall remain stayed.

However, this will be subject to a condition that petitioners will deposit a cost of Rs. 3,000/- each with the District Legal Services Authority, Jalandhar.
