Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 30.03.2022 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gururam, vide which bail/surety bonds of the petitioner are cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued, in FIR No.105 dated 23.02.2016 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 307, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 29.11.2016 passed in CRM-M-36404-2016 and was regularly appearing before the trial Court, however, on 30.03.2022, due to unavoidable circumstances, he could not

appear before the trial Court and his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the trial.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Grewal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid submissions, this petition is allowed. The impugned order dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) is set aside and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and he will be released on bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, concerned, however, subject to deposit the costs of Rs.5,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, concerned.
