Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner had approached this Court by way of filing CWP No.14998 of 2021, which was disposed of by this Court giving direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 30.06.2021 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months. Learned counsel argues that in pursuance to the said direction, respondent No.2 passed an order dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P-4) stating that the appropriate order can only be passed by respondent No.1.

Learned Counsel submits that respondent No.1 is not deciding the said legal notice in spite of issuance of direction by the competent Court of law.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to deciding the legal notice dated 30.06.2021, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-2 with the present petition by respondent No.1, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
