While granting the interim bail on 09.06.2022, following order
was passed:

“ The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by Jalwant Kaur seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 40, dated 1st May, 2022, under Sections 323, 308 read with 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is only that she raised a lalkara and no injury has been attributed to her. The main accused in the present case is the son of the petitioner namely Gurpreet Singh @ Kuki, who has already surrendered on 6th June, 2022. The petitioner is 62 years of age and no recovery is to be effected from her.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. He, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh submits that except lalkara no other allegation has been levelled against the petitioner in FIR. The petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Adjourned to 8th September, 2022.

Considering the facts and circumstances in totality the petitioner is granted interim bail subject to her joining investigation within 10 days. In the event of arrest, she shall be released on bail subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. She is directed to join the investigation as and when called for. She shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 09.06.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the afore-said fact. However, he, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of above, the order dated 09.06.2022 is made absolute

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
