The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 who are attempting to forcibly recover the truck of the petitioner bearing registration No. PB-05-AL-3411 and a further prayer to quash the action of respondent No.4 and 5 vide which the benefit of loan moratorium for the period commencing from 01.03.2020 to 31.08.2020 on account of COVID-19 has been denied.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the instant writ petition had been filed for seeking restraint against respondents from recovering the vehicle. However, they have already recovered the said vehicle, resultantly, the present

petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
