The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.52 dated 15.06.2021, registered under Sections 420 and 406 IPC of 1860, at P.S. Joga, District Mansa.

Vide order dated 19th July 2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted interim protection and further in pursuance of the order dated 03.12.2021, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre has been received wherein it has been mentioned that the parties have amicably settled their dispute.

Upon instructions from ASI Naib Singh, learned State counsel would submit that the parties have compromised the matter.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 19.07.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
