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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.178 dated 01.04.2016 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising out of it on the basis of the compromise dated 18.09.2018 (Annexure P-2).

On 13.09.2019 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Court below within 15 days for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise/settlement, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties and his/their status of being proclaimed offender/person.

As directed, report dated 05.11.2019 from the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, has been received,

as per which the parties had recorded their statements before the Trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them and none of the petitioners has been declared a proclaimed offender.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR which originates from a matrimonial dispute and the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.178 dated 01.04.2016 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar and all proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners.
