Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.68 dated 27.03.2022, registered for offence under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 23.05.2022, Annexure P-6, arrived at between the parties.

Heard counsel for the petitioner.

Petitioner is accused of instigating his wife to commit suicide. FIR, Annexure P-1, has been lodged by the brother of the deceased alleging that the petitioner was pressurizing her to ask her father for money.

When confronted with the nature of allegations and judgment of the Supreme Court in *The State of Madhya Pradesh Versus Laxmi Narayan and others 2019 (5) SCC 688* and of this Court in *CRM-M-38402-2021 titled as Jobandeep Singh Versus State of Punjab and another*, decided on 23.02.2022 and *CRM-M-1054-2022 titled as Neelam Devi and others Versus State of Punjab and another*, decided on 01.04.2022, counsel for the petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
