This petition was filed seeking directions to official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 (arrayed in the petition).

The grievance raised in the petition was that report dated 21.3.2019 was not being considered.

Learned State Counsel filed the status report dated 30.8.2019. As per the pleadings of the reply, allegations in representation was enquired into, it was found that there was no apprehension of threat to the petitioner from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5. During the enquiry, considering the MLR of the petitioner, the offence under Section 323 IPC was made out and DDR was registered vide GD No. 38 dated 15.02.2017. The enquiry officer suggested the petitioner to file a complaint.

In view of the reply, no further directions are called for.

Petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance, if any.
