This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed in FIR No. 6 dated 13.5.2022, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Amendment) Act, 2018, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 2.6.2022, granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI-Gulsher Singh submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation and is co-operating but his voice sample is required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions submits that the petitioner volunteers to give his voice sample.

As custody of the petitioner is not needed, the interim bail granted is made absolute, subject to petitioner's giving voice sample.
