Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 159 dated 18.08.2019, registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 147, 148, 149, 506 of the IPC [Section 3(2)(D) of SC/ST Act added later on) at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani.

As per the office report, process fee has not been filed.

Vide order dated 02.06.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 02.06.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajender Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
