HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

By this common order, two writ petitions, the details of which have been mentioned in the heading, are being disposed of as both the petitions involve similar question of law.

In the present petitions, the prayer of the petitioners is that the respondents invited applications for change of cadre, which notice inviting applications is annexed as Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that though the petitioners applied for change of cadre but no decision is being taken by the respondents, which act of the respondents is causing prejudice to the

petitioners. Learned counsel submit that the respondents be directed to pass appropriate decision on the requests of the petitioners submitted in pursuance to the notice dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that if the requests of the petitioners submitted in pursuance to the notice dated 05.04.2022, have not already been decided, the same will be decided by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submit that the petitioners be given liberty to supplement their representations also, so as to enable them to raise their grievances which have come into being after filing of this petition.

Learned State counsel submits that if any supplementary representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will also be taken into consideration while passing an appropriate order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petitions and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
