[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 09.12.2021 in CWP No.24927 of 2021 in case titled as RenuBala vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.24927 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 20.01.2020 as also by taking into account the contentions raised in the writ petition in accordance with law, expeditiously.

[3] Compliance report along with order, Annexure R/1 dated 22.06.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 20.01.2020 has already been filed in the Registry and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 22.06.2022 by way of

appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
