The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 08.4.2022 (Annexure P-3) in CIS No.NDPS/203/2021 with regard to FIR No.31 dated 24.2.2021, under Sections 392 and 482 IPC, Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act and Sections 21(b)/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City, Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 02.06.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court on 10.06.2022 and was admitted to interim bail. In support of his contentions, learned counsel for the petitioner has furnished the copy of order dated 10.6.2022 passed by the
