HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

By this common order, all the writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of, as all the petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are working as Edusat Chowkidars with the Education Department for the last more than a decade but the petitioners have not been given the benefit that their names have not been included in the seniority list so that the claim

of the petitioners for regularization of their services could be considered by the respondent-Department, which fact is causing prejudice to the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the only prayer of the petitioners is for framing a seniority of the Edusat Chowkidars by treating them as a class IV employee of the Education Department and regularize their services against the regular sanctioned post as and when their turn comes keeping in view the regularization policy of the year 2003, which according to the petitioners is continuous process.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioners files any detailed representation claiming the said relief, the said prayer will be considered by the competent authority and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as the respondents have decided to consider the claim of the petitioners, the respondents be restrained from terminating the services of the petitioners in any manner till the said decision is taken.

Keeping in view the above, the respondents are directed that in case, the petitioners raise any grievance as noticed hereinbefore by filing appropriate representation within next three weeks from the receipt of copy of this order, the respondents are directed to decide the same in accordance with law and the regularization policy, if any, which covers the case of the petitioners within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation. Till appropriate orders are passed, the petitioners, who are in service, will be allowed to continue in service.

All the writ petitions are disposed of in above terms.
