Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.988 dated 10.10.2018, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 420 and 415 IPC.

Vide order dated 30.10.2018 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Nar Singh, submits that the petitioner joined investigation on 28.08.2021, but did not join the same thereafter.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The allegation against the petitioner is that agreement to sell had been executed by the parties at his instance. So far as the agreement in question is concerned, the petitioner is not a party to the same and no recovery is to be effected from him.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner joined investigation on 28.08.2021, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.10.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
