Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.02 dated 03.01.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Women Police Station, Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.08.2022, petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant has joined the investigation. Still further, he submits that during pendency of the petition, matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court where a settlement/agreement dated 13.05.2022 has been

arrived at and parties are staying together.

Upon instructions from ASI Parwinder, State counsel has affirmed that petitioner has joined the investigation, he has cooperated with the investigation process and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the settlement, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 23.05.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
