The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to register an FIR against respondents No.5 and 6, on the basis of complaint dated 10.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) and the statement dated 24.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) made by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are co-sharers in the land measuring 05 kanals on the basis of the sale deed executed in their favour on 27.10.1975 by Ajit Singh; that the petitioners filed a civil suit against Gupreet Singh and Rajbir Singh (respondents No.5 and 6 herein) and vide order dated 30.04.2021 passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Phul, the parties to the suit had been directed to maintain status quo regarding the possession over the suit property.

Learned counsel further contends that in spite of the aforesaid order passed by the Civil Court, the private respondents alongwith others started demolishing the rooms constructed on the land

owned by the petitioners and had taken the law in their own hands.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 has moved a representation dated 10.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, for redressal of the grievance, which has not been decided yet. Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied, if the said representation is ordered to be decided within a stipulated time.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4-State only, at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State, and draws the attention of this Court towards the letter dated 03.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) written by the Office of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to the DGP, Punjab, (Grievance Cell), regarding the status of the private respondents i.e. Gurpreet Singh and Rajveer Singh, being co-sharers in the land as per the revenue records.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to decide the representation dated 10.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) moved by petitioner No.1, within a period of two months after receiving the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
