Learned counsel for the State, with reference to the compliance report filed by way of affidavit dated 07.07.2022 of District Collector, Rewari, submits that the possession has been handed over of the encroached area after eviction. In this regard, reference has been made to para 3 of the said affidavit. The said para reads as follows:-

*“3. That on 04-12-2021 the eviction proceedings were carried out but not completed due to the unavailability of cutter machine and labour as required by the Halqa Girdawar for removal of the steel and concrete wall. The true translated copy of possession proceedings dated 04-12-2021 is attached herewith as **Annexure R-1.***

*Thereafter on 20-04-2022 the illegal encroachment of the respondents no. 5 to 9 was removed from the spot and the possession was handed over to the concerned Gram Sachiv and Block Patwari. The true translated copy of possession proceedings dated 20-04-2022 is attached herewith as **Annexure R-2.***

After receipt of order dated 01-06-2022 passed by the Hon'ble High Court, deponent directed

*Tehsildar, Rewari to verify the illegal encroachment and to remove the encroachment if still remaining on the spot. In consequence there of, Tehsildar, Rewari visited the spot along with concerned Patwari and Girdawar on 14-06-2022 and submitted his report along with the satisfaction report of the petitioner, concerned Gram Sachiv and Patwari and other inhabitants of the village to the deponent vide memo no. 176/Reader dated 01-07-2022. The true translated copy of the report dated 01-07-2022 along with attendance list is attached herewith as **Annexure R-3**. It is also pertinent to mention here that present petitioner namely Koshalya has been completely satisfied regarding the possession proceeding conducted by the Tehsildar, Rewari on 14.06.2022 as per attendance list.”*

Counsel for the petitioner acknowledges the said aspect and, therefore, submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.
