SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

By this petition, the petitioners seeks quashing of the order dated 05.12.2019 passed by respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur (Annexure P-13) whereby, the representation submitted by them has been 'fled away'.

The grievance of the petitioners was with regard to in-action on the part of official respondents against respondent No.6, which is alleged to have cheated the poor and needy villagers apart from embezzled essential commodities supplied by the State Government under the Public Distribution System.

An affidavit dated 29.10.2020 of Sh. Bhupinder Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur filed on behalf of respondents No.1, 3 and 5 by the counsel for the State is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has referred to para Nos. 4 and 5 of the above affidavit, which reads as under:-

“4. That during enquiry DSP (PBI), Ferozepur, perused the enquiry report No.4901/PC Dated 15.12.2019 conducted by Incharge EO Wing, Ferozepur on the basis of application bearing No.6137-PC dated 13.08.2018 moved by petitioners and others before the then SSP, Ferozepur. Except this enquiry officer had also carefully overused the enquiry report No.2018/177 Dated 04.09.2018 of Assistant Food and Supplies Officer, Ferozepur. From which it is transpired that during enquiry conducted by Food and Supplies Department it was found that respondent no.6 was depot Holder and he was found that he commit fault while distrusting the rations to the card holders and on the basis of said enquiry report license of respondent no.6 had already been cancelled by the Food and Supplies Department vide order no.2018/5357 dated 05.12.2018. Against said order respondent no.6 had preferred an appeal before Additional Director Food and Supplies and Consumer Affairs and said appeal of respondent no.6 was dismissed vide order dated 02.09.2019.

5. That after going through the entire record DSP (PBI), Ferozepur recommend to register the case u/s 420 IPC against respondent no.6. On the basis of said report of DSP (PBI), Ferozepur case bearing FIR No. 54 Dated 16.10.2020 U/s 420 IPC Police Station Arif ke, District Ferozepur has been registered against respondent No.6.”

In view of afore-said affidavit, the grievance raised by the petitioners stands addressed and no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.

With the redressal of the grievance of the petitioners, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed off, as such.

Ordered accordingly.
