1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-2, dated 23.12.2021, in CWP-26617-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-2 dated 23.12.2021, reveals that CWP-26617-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider representation dated 06.02.2020, moved by the petitioner and decide the same, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced speaking order dated 01.09.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 06.02.2020. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order dated 06.02.2020, by way of appropriate

proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against respondent No.1 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
