Petitioner has filed the present petition for seeking quashing the FIR No.7960 dated 23.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 135/138 of Electricity Act 2003 at Police Station Irrigation and Power, District Gurugram and further proceedings arising thereof.

Today the State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 made statement that theft penalty amount of Rs.15149557/- (Assessment charge Rs.1,42,49,557/- and compounding charge Rs.9,00,000/-), has been recovered from the petitioners and they further submitted that cancellation report was

presented and the same was accepted in Lok Adalat on 9.12.2021. Both the counsel admitted that the offence has been compounded and they have no objection if the present petition is allowed. They also produced documents with regard to the compounding of offence and the same are ordered to be taken on record.

In view of the above, as the matter has been compromised between the parties and the entire amount including the compounding charges have been paid by the petitioners to the respondent No.2, no purpose will be served by keeping the aforesaid criminal proceedings pending against the petitioners.

For the foregoing reasons, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.7960 dated 23.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 135/138 of Electricity Act 2003 at Police Station Irrigation and Power, District Gurugram along with all the subsequent proceedings thereof are quashed qua the present petitioners.

Disposed of accordingly.
