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**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the husband of petitioner No.1 namely Narender Singh was working with respondent No.3 society and while in service, he unfortunately died on 23.03.2016 but no benefit in respect of the service rendered by the late husband of petitioner No.1 was ever extended to petitioner No.1 or to the other legal heirs.

Learned counsel submits that no order has been passed by the respondent declining the said benefit but the same has also not been extended either to petitioner No.1 or other legal heirs and that too without any valid justification .

Learned counsel submits that the grievance as raised in the present petition has already been raised by petitioner No.1 in the representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration with respondent No.3 and the petitioner will be satisfied if respondent No.3 is directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to deciding the representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) moved by petitioner No.1, in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) moved by petitioner No.1, by passing an appropriate speaking order on the same within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision on the representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same be released to her within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.
