The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 91 dated 02.04.2011 under Sections 302, 427, 148, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Payal, Khanna, District Ludhiana and all subsequent proceedings qua the petitioner.

A perusal of the petition would show that neither the order declaring the present petitioner as proclaimed offender nor zimni orders of the Court have been annexed herewith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, there is no order declaring the present petitioner as proclaimed offender and therefore, seeks to withdraw the present petition after annexing all the zimni orders and also after showing all the reports in which it has been mentioned that there is no order declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender.
