This writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, has been filed for issuance of a writ, order or direction to respondents Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that one Chand Masih is the relative of the petitioners but they have no knowledge regarding his whereabouts. In fact, FIR No.96 dated 10.05.2022, under Sections 363, 366 IPC, Police Station City Gurdaspur stands registered against the said Chand Masih. However, the Police has not been able to catch hold of the accused Chand Masih in the said FIR. The petitioners are being harassed by the Police officials to know about the whereabouts of said Chand Masih. A representation dated 28.05.2022 (Annexure P-1), in this behalf has been made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur as well as to the Station House Officer, Police Station City Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to look into the matter and decide the representation dated 28.05.2022 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the matter is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to consider and decide the representation dated 28.05.2022 (Annexure P-1) and thereafter take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
