ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel has opposed the present petition on the grounds that the proceedings under Section 304 A IPC, when it relates to road side death in a motor accident, cannot be quashed.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition and prayed for issuance of directions to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

Given the compromise which has already been effected between the family of the victim and petitioner, prayer being innocuous is accepted.
