United Breweries Ltd. Vs. Statye of Haryana & others

Present: Mr. N.K. Setia, Advocate for the applicant/petitioner.

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CM-9076-CWP-2022:

In view of the averments made in the application, duly supported by an affidavit of the counsel himself, we find that sufficient cause has been shown to justify the condonation of delay of 24 days that has occurred in filing the accompanying review application.

Prayer is allowed.

Delay in re-filing the review application is condoned.

Application is disposed of.

RA-CW-109-2022:

Counsel at the very outset makes a statement that he has instructions not to pursue the instant review application. Rather he seeks indulgence of this Court to extend the time frame that had been granted by this Court in the order dated 20.02.2020 while disposing of CWP-21099-2019 for purposes of filing a reply to the notice.

Since the applicant/petitioner had been advised to file a review application and was pursuing the same, we are inclined to accept the limited prayer raised by counsel.

Accordingly, while disposing of the instant review application as not pressed, we clarify that in case the applicant/petitioner files a reply to the notice referred to in the order dated 20.02.2020 passed by this Court

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within a period of six weeks from today, the same would be considered on merits and in accordance with law.
