The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of necessary directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action against the respondent No.4 in view of the DDR No.21 dated 06.01.2018 registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 26.10.2018, pursuant to which the learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit dated 29.08.2022. He makes a reference to para 9 thereof, which read as under:-

“That the false allegations have been leveled against the police. No illegality or impropriety has been committed

by the police in the present matter. The police has acted in the present matter properly. The animals of the petitioner did not die due to any poisonous substance as revealed during the enquiry, so no action was taken on the DDR No.21 dated 06.01.2018 of P.S. Bahav Wala recorded on the statement of the petitioner. No cause of action has accrued to the petitioner to file the present petition.

It is therefore, respectfully prayed that in view of the submissions made above, the present petition may kindly be dismissed, in the interest of justice.”

In view of the above, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
