Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears of revised pay scale to the petitioners w.e.f. 01.01.2006 to 31.07.2009.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the representation dated 10.03.2020 (P-13) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioners, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 10.03.2020 (P-13) by passing reasoned order as per law within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
