The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.556 dated 13.09.2021 registered under Sections 66-D, 120-B, 201, 419, 420 IPC at Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, District Bhiwani.

The operative part of the order dated 02.06.2022, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“....Mr. Aman Pal, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is identically placed like the petitioner in CRM-M-24319 of 2022 titled Sudeep Fogaat vs State of Haryana.

Notice of motion for 24.08.2022.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is also directed to join the investigation and

cooperate with the Investigating Agency, as and when required....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 02.06.2022, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that while the anticipatory bail of the petitioners was dismissed, however, the Additional Sessions Judge has granted anticipatory bail to the similarly situated 08 co-accused of the petitioner namely Udham Singh, Manjeet, Kuldeep, Manoj Kumar, Raj Singh Tewatia, Vinesh, Sachin and Jitender.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Krishan Kumar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 02.06.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
