HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prayer in the present petition is to count the work charged service rendered by the petitioner from 01.09.1969 to 14.05.1979 as qualifying service for computing his pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though notice of motion has been issued but the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 31.10.2019 (Annexure P-2) filed by him, which is still pending consideration with the respondents. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner may kindly be given liberty to supplement the said legal notice dated 31.10.2019, which the petitioner will file within a period of one week from today.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection to the aforesaid prayer of the petitioner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice 31.10.2019 (Annexure P-2) along with any supplementary notice which the petitioner may file seeking the relief as has been sought in the present petition, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after deciding the said legal notice, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be released to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.
