The petitioner was granted interim bail for two months on 23.05.2019 on the medical grounds and thereafter from time to time the same was extended. However, on 28.03.2022 the interim bail granted to the petitioner was vacated and he was directed to surrender before the jail authorities forthwith and the matter was fixed for final arguments.

Today, nobody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner and the learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has submitted that the petitioner has not surrendered before the jail authorities despite the fact that the interim bail was vacated by this court.

In view of the aforesaid position the present petition is dismissed.
