Petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C, pending trial in case FIR No.161 dated 30.11.2014 registered under Sections 302, 323, 324, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer only in respect of expeditious trial, as the accused is in custody for almost four years and out of twenty six witnesses, only six witnesses have been examined so far.

Considering the above background, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within six months.
