The present petition has been filed for quashing of impugned order dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P-3) by which, the respondents have imposed recovery upon the petitioner.

It is a conceded position that against the said punishment, the petitioner has already filed an appeal before the Board of Directors/Board of Administrators, Hafed, Panchkula, which is still pending consideration.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said appeal.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents raises

no objection for deciding the appeal filed by the petitioner against the impugned order dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner against the impugned order dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P-3), if not already decided, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

In case, after the decision of the appeal, it is found that the petitioner becomes entitled for any benefits, the same be also released to him within a period of six weeks thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
