Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.266 dated 11.08.2017, under Sections 307, 34 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, Julana, District Jind as their request in this regard made through representation dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-4 colly) to Director General of Police, Jind (respondent No.2) and Station House Officer, Police Station, Julana (Respondent No.4) has not been looked into.

As per the averments in the petition, after registration of the case, the accused persons threatened the petitioners and proclaimed that nothing can happen to them as they are closely related to the senior police officers.

Lastly, this case was listed on 02.05.2018 and at that stage,

respondent No.5 was at large and his arrest warrants already stood issued.

Today, learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent Nos.6 and 7 have stated that after completion of investigation, the final report was submitted before the trial court and the trial is in progress. Learned State counsel, on instructions from PSI Mukesh Kumar, has stated that out of total nineteen prosecution witnesses, ten have been examined. He has further stated that respondent No.5 has already been declared proclaimed offender.

Considering the above background of this case, particularly the advanced stage of trial, no further orders are called for in respect of investigation of the case.
