This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuing of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct the investigation expeditiously and properly in case DDR No.29 dated 05.04.2019 (Annexure P-2), registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 452, 427, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Valtaha, District Tara Taran and to submit the challan before the Competent Court of jurisdiction.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the cancellation report has been submitted on 02.05.2022 and notice has been issued to the complainant for 17.05.2022 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
