The chak of an existing outlet has been split into two on an application having been moved by the private respondents. Appeal and revision preferred by the petitioner have failed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that due to splitting of the chak, the land of the petitioner's will not get adequate irrigation as the land of the private respondents is at a lower level.

The argument cannot be accepted as the same was not raised before any of the authorities below. In any case, the turn of water can be arranged in a manner that both parties draw water at different times.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
